“We strongly encourage women to apply for the remaining Board positions to increase the diversity of the Board,” said Pride Toronto Co-Chair, Luka Amona.

Pride Toronto members will elect the three board members through a Single Transferable Vote system at Pride Toronto’s General Meeting on March 1.

“Our goal is to ensure better representation from all parts of the community which Pride Toronto serves, including historically marginalized and disadvantaged communities,” said Pride Toronto Co-Chair, Francisco Alvarez.

Pride Toronto’s Board of Directors committed to opening the remaining vacant positions at Pride Toronto’s Annual General Meeting on October 27.
